

# Acer circinatum

## VINE MAPLE

### Outstanding Qualities

This versatile Northwest native can be a useful addition to a small garden. Often the trunks show a rugged and architectural grace. The fresh, light green leaves turn orange and red in the fall, often holding their fall color for an extended period. It is very easy to grow.

### Culture

Vine maples will grow in full sun to full shade (fall color is best with at least half a day of sun) and will grow in a wide range of soils. This tree is drought tolerant once established.

### Growing Habit

*Acer circinatum* becomes an upright multi-stemmed large shrub or small tree. Expect twelve to eighteen inches of growth a year in youth, gradually slowing to four to six inches a year. It will mature to a height of fifteen to twenty feet with an equal spread.

### Hardiness
