Agapanthus Field Evaluation Report 16 August 2002

All plants were given a numerical score from 1 (worst) to five (best). Scores on this report reflect the average of three to four individual scores.

A. 'Loch Hope'	4.7	4.5	4.5		5.0		habit upright, dense, stiff, foliage dark green medium wide 18" long, flower head large, floral tubes long and striped, flower deep blue, showy flower buds	
A. 'Streamline'	3.6	3.6	3.6		3.6		habit dwarf, foliage narrow, flower stems stout and about 2', flowers pale blue with lavender-blue stripes and they face out well
