T. chloropetalum 'White Form'	4.7	4.6	4.6	4.6	4.6	5.0	4.6	Foliage green and mottled with darker green and with purple-green-brown in the younger leaves, flowers white and rose scented, stems green.	
T. cuniatum	4.5	4.5	5.0	N/A	4.5	4.0	4.5	Foliage distinctly mottled, silvery-green foliage, plants the same age smaller than T. chloropetalum, flowers maroon, stems reddish.	
T. erectum	4.7	5.0	5.0	N/A	4.0	5.0	4.5	Foliage green, flowers 1" across dark red and nodding, long blooming, some evidence of slug damage.	
T. grandiflorum	4.8	5.0	5.0	N/A	4.5	4.5	5.0	Foliage green, plants budded, clumps large for time in the ground, a vigorous grower.	
T. grandiflorum 'Roseum'	4.6	5.0	5.0	N/A	4.5	4.0	4.5	Leaves green on top and purplish underneath, stems purplish, plant budded.	
T. luteum	3.0	3.0	4.0	N/A	4.0	4.0	4.0	Foliage mottled green and purplish-brown, plants budded.

T. tschonoskii	4.0	5.0	5.0	2.0	4.6	4.3	3.3	Foliage green and large almost 12" across, flowers very small maybe 1" and dark red	

Notes: The use of N/A in the Flower/Fruit column indicates that the plants were not in bloom at the time of the trial.
